Summary of KCK 10/7/08 Board Meeting

Board members present were Kathy Luchsinger, Jim Davis, and Marv Copley. Non Board member attendees included Richard Sepersky and Alden Worachek.

- At the prior Board meeting the Board accepted the resignation of Alden Worachek due to other pressing responsibilities. The Board thanked Walden for his contributions. Alden agreed to maintain check writing responsibilities and prepare the year end financial statements. Minutes from the last Board meeting were accepted by the Board.
- -Marv raised the issue of attracting potential instructors for the beginning sea kayaking class in return for funding a portion of their ACA advanced sea kayaking instructor certification. The club is trying to trying to expand the club instructor base. At this point the Board is only soliciting an indication of interest from anyone interested. Marv will find out the facts concerning the certification courses.
- -The Board especially wanted to thank Jim Gonski for stepping up to teach the Sea Kayak and IK class, Eric Downey and Jim King for the rafting class and Marv Copley for coordinating the Safety Class. Several members that historically had done this have left the state.
- -The Board had expected to hold discussions with Sam Steele, who indicated a desire to have the club sponsor a Pacraft class in the spring. He indicated that, through an email sent out through the Eddyline, several people indicted an interest in taking this type of class. Sam emailed mid day on the day of the Board meeting that he would be unable to attend the meeting. The Board indicated he would be welcome to address a future meeting. Eric Downey indicated a willingness to organize the class. The Board has not decided whether to organize the class and seek instructors or seek a commercial vendor to teach the class.
- -The November Thanksgiving Potluck was discussed. The Potluck will be held on November 20 at the Russian Jack Park Chalet. The club provides Turkey, Ham sodas, plates and silverware. Club members are asked to bring a potluck. This important meeting is also when the new Board is elected, volunteering opportunities are discussed and members provide some ideas regarding what activities and what direction the club should take.
